1. Government of India (GOI) has approved a new Centrally Sponsored Scheme National Livestock Mission for implementation during 2021-22 to 2025-26. The objective of the scheme is to support entrepreneurship development for rural poultry, sheep and goat, piggery, feed and fodder and also improvement of breed of sheep, goat and as well as fodder production. The scheme is being implemented by Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying. The Scheme Guidelines were issued and has been made available at website at www.dahd.nic.in.
2. As per the requirement under the scheme, Tamil Nadu Livestock Development Agency, the SIA nominated by the Animal Husbandry Department, State Government of Tamil Nadu invites applications from individuals, FPOs, JLGs, SHGs and Section 8 companies for availing benefits under the Entrepreneurship programme for establishment of the following projects:
 - a. Rural Poultry Entrepreneurship Model for establishment of Parent Farm of 1000 birds of Low Input Technology, Hatchery for production of chicks and brooder mother units for brooding and rearing of the chicks.
 - b. Breeder Farm of sheep and goats of 100 females and 5 males for production of kids /lambs or its multiples; 200+10, or 300+15, or 400+20 or 500+25.
 - c. Piggery Breeder farm of 50 sows and 5 boars or 100 sows and 10 boars for production of piglets and fattening of piglets.
 - d. Feed and Fodder entrepreneurship for establishment of silage making unit, fodder block making unit and TMR plant.
3. The details of projects, eligibility criteria, list of equipment eligible for funding (Annexure I.)
4. Eligibility Criteria for the Entrepreneurs/ Eligible Entities to avail benefit under NLM: -

The Entrepreneurs/ Eligible Entities shall be considered Eligible for availing benefits under the entrepreneurship programme if fulfils either of the following criteria:

 - Entrepreneurs/ Eligible Entities either have obtained training or have trained experts or have sufficient experience in the relevant field in managing and running the project or have technical experts with sufficient experience in the relevant field of managing and running the project.

- The Entrepreneurs/ Eligible Entities have got the sanction loan for project by the bank or financial institutions, furnished bank guarantee from scheduled bank along with appraisal of project for its validity by bank where it is holding the account.
 - The Entrepreneurs/ Eligible Entities should have own land or lease land where the project will be established.
 - The Entrepreneurs/ Eligible Entities have all the relevant documents for KYC
5. The Eligible Beneficiaries who are fulfilling the criteria under the scheme, shall apply through the online portal: <https://www.nlm.udyamimitra.in/> though a form for application and required documents has been provided at Annexure III. The programme is sanctioned to be implemented upto 2025-26.
 6. The invitation for EOI is valid for one year and it is extendable from time-to-time upto the sanction period of the programme
 7. Evaluation Criteria has been provided at Annexure I.
 - The EOI will be screened and evaluated for short listing *inter alia* based on their eligibility conditions and verifications.
 - Agencies / individuals who qualify and short listed will be eligible for benefits under the scheme.
 - However, subsidy will be provided depending on the budget availability under NLM Scheme.

8. Project Approval of entrepreneurship programmes:

- The Entrepreneurs/ Eligible Entities shall submit the application through the NLM Portal to the State Implementing Agency in response to Expression of Interest issued by the State Implementing Agency.
- The applications submitted by the Entrepreneurs/ Eligible Entities will be scrutinised by the State Implementing Agency and will be recommended for sanction of loan by the Scheduled Bank or Financial Institutions like NCDC, etc.
- After the recommendation of the project, the same will be considered by the bank or financial institutions for financing.
- Once the Entrepreneurs/ Eligible Entities obtains the bank or financial institution sanction of the project, the State Implementing Agency shall place the same in the State Level Executive Committee (SLEC) for recommending the application to the Central Government. After approval of SLEC, the SIA will mark the application to the Central Government through the Portal to DAHD along with uploading the sanction for the loan component.
- The DAHD shall approve the project through the Project Approval Committee and fund the subsidy amount for the approved projects through Small Industries Development

Bank of India (SIDBI) to the lending bank or financial institution as the case may be to release the subsidy to beneficiaries

9. Fund Flow for the Entrepreneurship programmes (Central sector Component):

- All the subsidy amount will be channelized through the Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI).
- In respect of the entrepreneurship programme, the subsidy will be provided by SIDBI to the lending Scheduled Bank or Financial Institution like NCDC, etc., to the subsidy account of beneficiaries. The SIDBI on receipt of the subsidy component, shall release the first instalment of subsidy to the appropriate account of Entrepreneurs/ Eligible Entities after disbursement of minimum 25% of total loan sanctioned.
- In case of the self-financing project, the first instalment of back ended subsidy will be provided by SIDBI to the lending scheduled bank where the beneficiary has account. Such self-financed projects, prior to its sanction, would also be appraised by the Bank where the Entrepreneurs/ Eligible Entities has the account. The first instalment of subsidy will be released only when the beneficiary has made expenditure of 25% cost for the project towards infrastructure and has been verified by the State Implementing Agency. Remaining amount of subsidy will be provided after completion of the project and verified by State Implementing Agency.
- The beneficiaries interested in taking benefit under the entrepreneurship project in self-financing mode need to provide Bank Guarantee from the scheduled bank for the remaining cost of the project beyond the capital subsidy sought for support. This Bank Guarantee shall be valid for three years and to be drawn in favour of Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying. The original Bank Guarantee is to be kept in the safe custody of the State Implementing Agency. Also, a copy of the Bank Guarantee and a declaration form need to be uploaded in the online portal at the submission of the application or to be attached with the application. The Format of the Bank Guarantee and declaration has been annexed with the guidelines.

10. Where there is any indication that a conflict of interest exists or may arise, it shall be the responsibility of the Eligible Entity to disclose and inform the State Implementing Agency detailing the conflict in writing as an attachment to this document. State Implementing Agency will be the final arbitrator in cases of potential conflicts of interest. Failure to notify any potential conflict of interest will invalidate the application.

11. The EOI is an offer and is issued with no commitment. State Implementing Agency reserves the right to withdraw EOI and or vary part, thereof, at any stage. The State

Implementing Agency further reserves the right to disqualify any applicant, should it be necessary at any stage.

Background

1. The Department of Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Government of India is implementing the scheme of National Livestock Mission since the financial year 2021-22. The scheme of National Livestock Mission (NLM) aims towards employment generation, entrepreneurship development, increase in per animal productivity and thus targeting increased production of meat, goat milk, egg and wool. The concept of NLM Scheme is to develop the entrepreneurs in poultry, sheep & goat, pig, feed and fodder development in order to create the forward and backward linkage for the produce available at the unorganized sector and to link with the organized sector.
2. The NLM has decided to develop entrepreneurship in the rural poultry development, sheep & goat, piggery, feed & fodder development in order to invite the private investment as well as the rural youth to come forward in these sector so as to enable them self-reliant. This will help the country Atmanirbhar in the meat, egg and wool production which after meeting the domestic demands can be exported to earn foreign exchange.
3. The Government of India has decided to incentivize such entrepreneurship development through providing 50% back-ended subsidy for the project cost as mentioned against each of the entrepreneurship projects attached with this EOI.
4. **All the projects envisaged should preferably have a Hub and Spoke models where the beneficiary entrepreneur will act as Hub and the farmers of the catchment area will get the benefit of the produce of hub. In this way, chain of forward and backward linkage will be developed for better pricing of the products produced by the farmers.**
5. **Eligible Entities:** Individual, Farmers Producer Organizations, Self Help Group, Joint Liability Group, Section 8 companies.
6. **Eligibility Criteria for the Entrepreneurs to avail benefit.**

8. Release of subsidy to the Beneficiaries:

- 50% capital subsidy up to the ceiling of subsidy mentioned against each project will be released to beneficiaries in two equal instalments by SIDBI.
- First instalment will be released upfront to the lending bank which will be credited to beneficiary account after the bank releases first instalment of loan to the beneficiary and its confirmation by State Implementing Agency. The release of subsidy will be entered in the portal also.
- Beneficiaries will be eligible for the second instalment after completion of the project and certified so by the implementing Agency and returnable through the portal.
- State Implementing Agency will follow up the project for the period of 2 years after completion with regards to its operation.

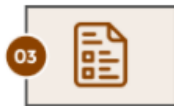

02. Screening of application by State Implementing Agency (SIA)

SIA will scrutinize the submitted application and will recommend the application of the entrepreneurs/ eligible entities to avail balance financing for the project through scheduled banks or financial institutions like National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC) etc.



03. Loan sanction by Lender

After the recommendation of the project by SIA, the same will be considered by the bank or financial institutions for financing. Lender will pick the application along with all the documents from the portal and will approve the loan after examining the project/ documents submitted by applicant and completing their internal diligent process. After sanctioning the loan, Lender will upload sanction letter on the portal.



04. Recommendation from State Level Executive Committee (SLEC)

Once the bank or financial institution sanction the project, SIA shall place the same in SLEC for recommending the application to the Central Government (Department of Animal Husbandry & Dairying).



05. Approval of subsidy by DAHD

DAHD will approve the subsidy and will mark the approval of the same on portal.



06. Disbursement and release of subsidy
